Helps

1. Adam (Genesis 2:19)
 - a. Red, ruddy, of the ground, human being. The color red lies behind the hebrew root adam. This may reflect the red soil from which he was made.
 - b. God formed him from the ground. (Genesis 2:7)
2. Enoch, Aaron (Exodus 7:1); Nathan (2 Samuel 7:2, 1 Kings 1:22-23); Elijah (1 Kings 18), Elisha (2 Kings 6); Daniel; see the books of the Bible from Isaiah through Malachi; Jesus; John (Revelation).
3. A few are: David (1 Samuel 16-17, 2 Samuel 2:1-7); Saul (1 Samuel 9-11); Joash (2 Kings 12:1-16); Solomon (1 Kings 1:5-53); Nebuchadnezzar (Daniel 1:1-4:34)
4. Enoch (Genesis 5:21-24) and Elijah (2 Kings 2:5-15)
5. Moses (Exodus 3:1-33, 8:1-2)
6. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego (Daniel 1:1-8); Paul (Romans 16:3); Silas, Timothy, Philip (John 1:43-51); Barnabas (Acts 4:36-37, 11:22-26, 13:1-7); Aquila and Priscilla (Acts 18:18-28); Apollos (Acts 18:24, 19:1, 1 Cor 3:4-6)
7. Daniel (Daniel 6:10-11)
8. John the Baptist (Matthew 3:1-4)
9. The end of time on our earth, heaven and the new earth. (Revelation)
