Helps

- **1.** Adam (Genesis 2:19)
 - **a.** Red, ruddy, of the ground, human being. The color red lies behind the hebrew root adam. This may reflect the red soil from which he was made.
 - **b.** God formed him from the ground. (Genesis 2:7)
- **2.** Enoch, Aaron (Exodus 7:1); Nathan (2 Samuel 7:2, 1 Kings 1:22-23); Elijah (1 Kings 18), Elisha (2 Kings 6); Daniel; see the books of the Bible from Isaiah through Malachi; Jesus; John (Revelation).
- **3.** A few are: David (1 Samuel 16-17, 2 Samuel 2:1-7); Saul (1 Samuel 9-11); Joash Kings 12:1-16); Solomon (1 Kings 1:5-53); Nebuchadnezzar (Daniel 1:1-4:34)
