



Seasons

1. Read and discuss Ecclesiastes 3:1–8.

2. Illustrate Ecclesiastes 3:11.

Helps: Suggestions: collage, sidewalk chalk drawing, drawing, charades, poster, etc.

3. Identify the time of year for the seasons in your area.

Helps: Your area may have the four distinct seasons, while other areas may have only two.

4. How do you prepare for each season: clothing, gardening, harvesting, activities, school, etc.

Helps: Discuss proper clothing, types of flowers/plants, and activities appropriate for each season.

5. Play a game related to the seasons.

Helps: Memory games, sorting games (clothing for seasons), Harvest the Carrot (simplified Capture the Flag).

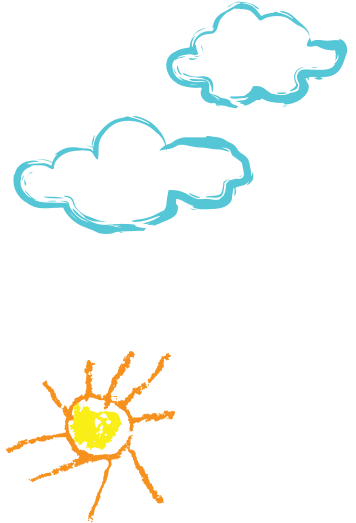
2 ACTIVITY

Color, cut out, and assemble the Seasons Wheel.

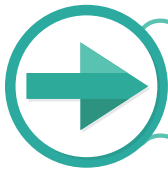
MATERIALS NEEDED

Winter Dress Up

Winter Dress Up Relay

Step 1: Divide your Adventurers into two teams. If one team has less players, one Adventurer on that team will have to take two turns.

Step 2: Pile the clothing at the opposite end of the room or at a marked distance.

Step 3: When the leader says “Go” the first Adventurer runs to the pile of clothes, puts them on, then runs back to start and removes the clothes.

Step 4: The second Adventurer puts on the clothes, runs to the opposite side of the room, removes the clothes leaving them in a pile, and runs back to start.

The relay continues until the last player completes the relay. The team that finishes first wins. You can also play against the clock and try to improve your time.

Instructions:

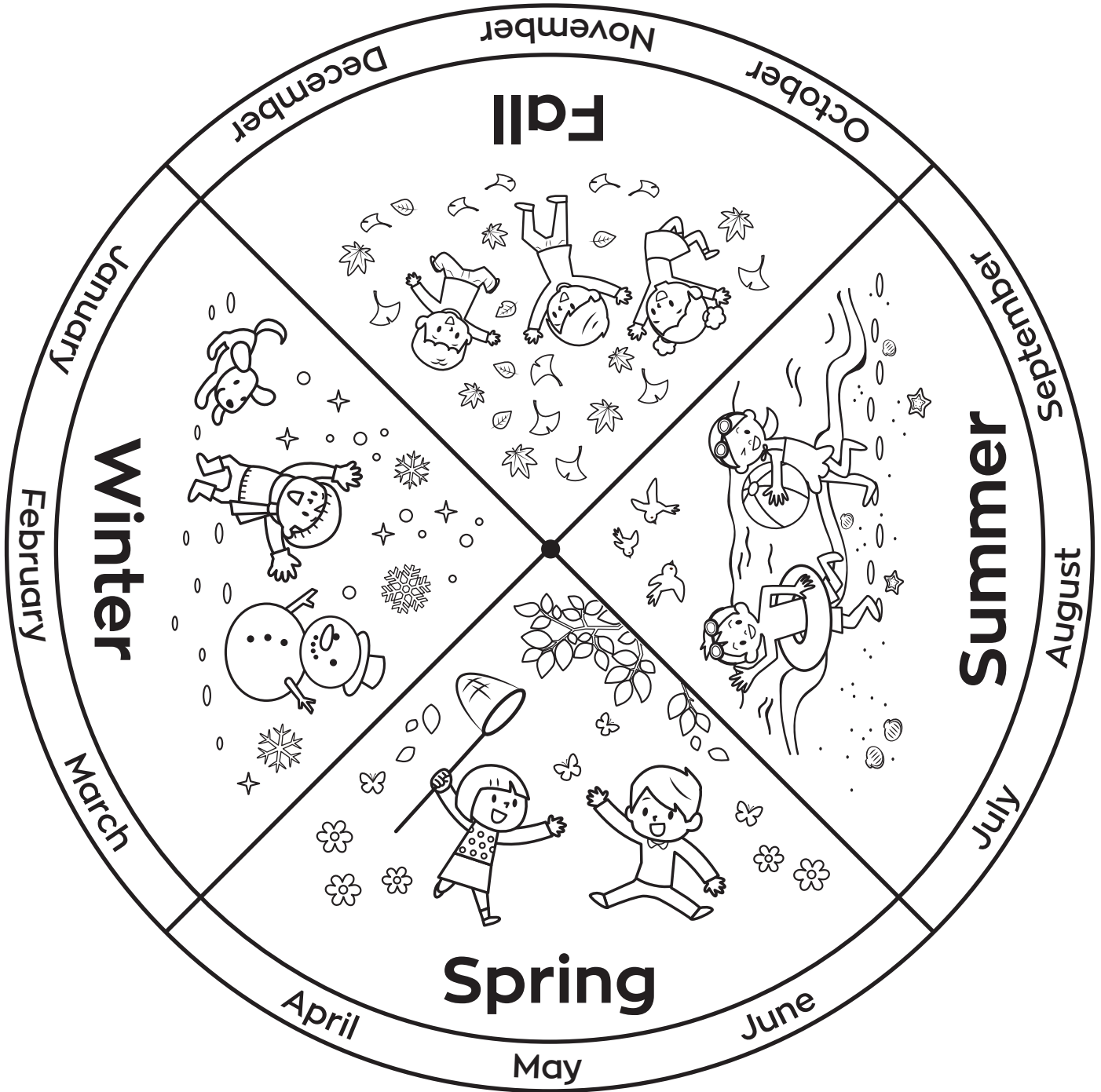
1. Color the top and bottom of the Seasons Wheel.
