Join us in Reaching North America and transforming the church for the Glory of God.


Early Bird registration packets mailed

The five evening sessions will cover topics that many find troubling as they read news articles and hear brief report


of recent research that often raise questions in the creation versus evolution debate.

According to Standish, it is important for Christians to understand the debate since it ultimately centers around whom we worship and how we worship. Revelation 14:7 tells us to "Worship Him who made the heavens, the earth, the sea and the springs of water." "The Bible is very clear," says Standish, "Nature did not create itself."

Dr. Clouzet added, "Creation stands at the core of Christian theology. If death existed before sin, as it must have if theistic evolution is true, then Jesus' death on the cross and victory over sin are not logically tied to our salvation. People struggle to find complex solutions to this particular conundrum, but the Bible is not ambiguous."
