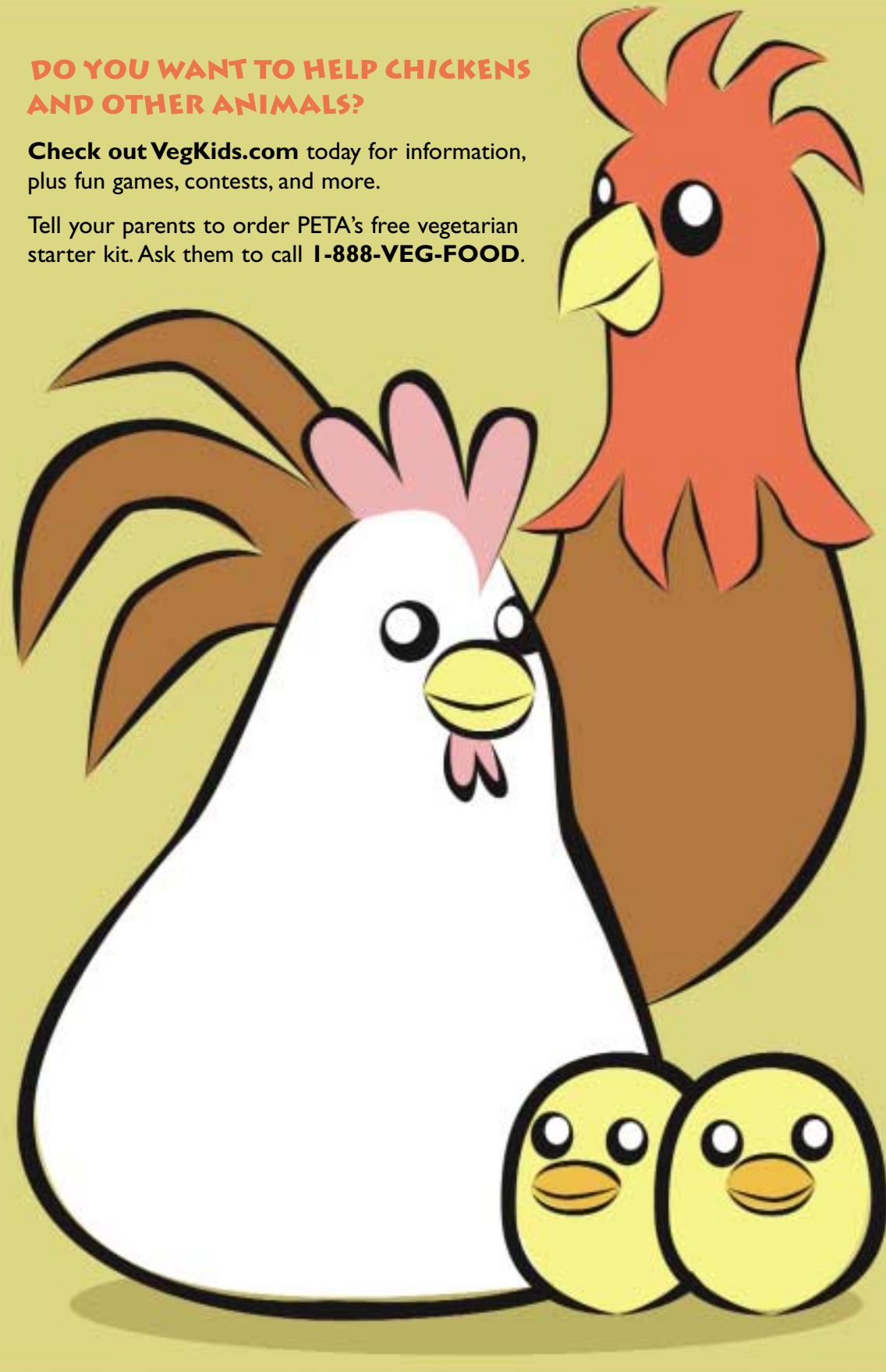

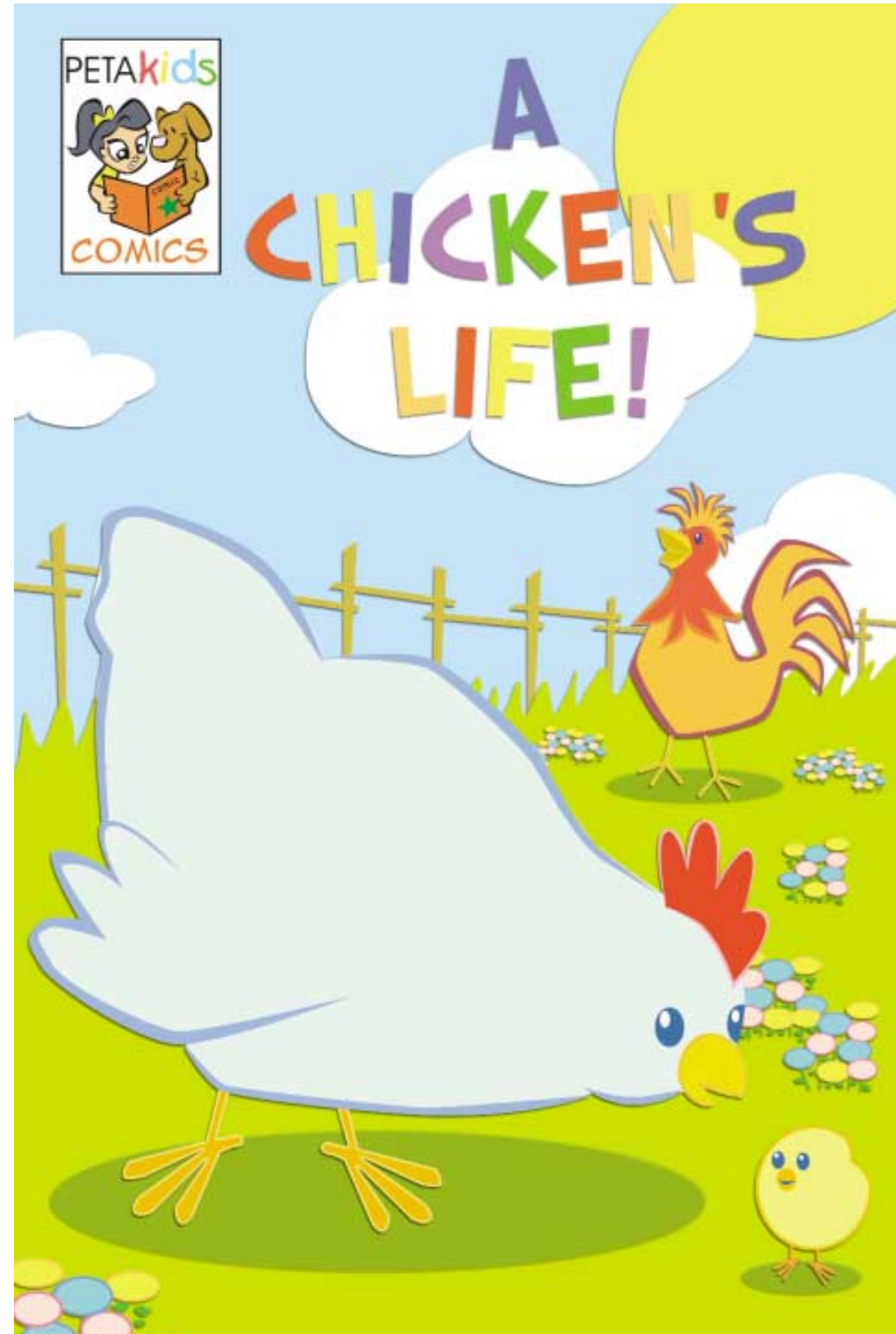

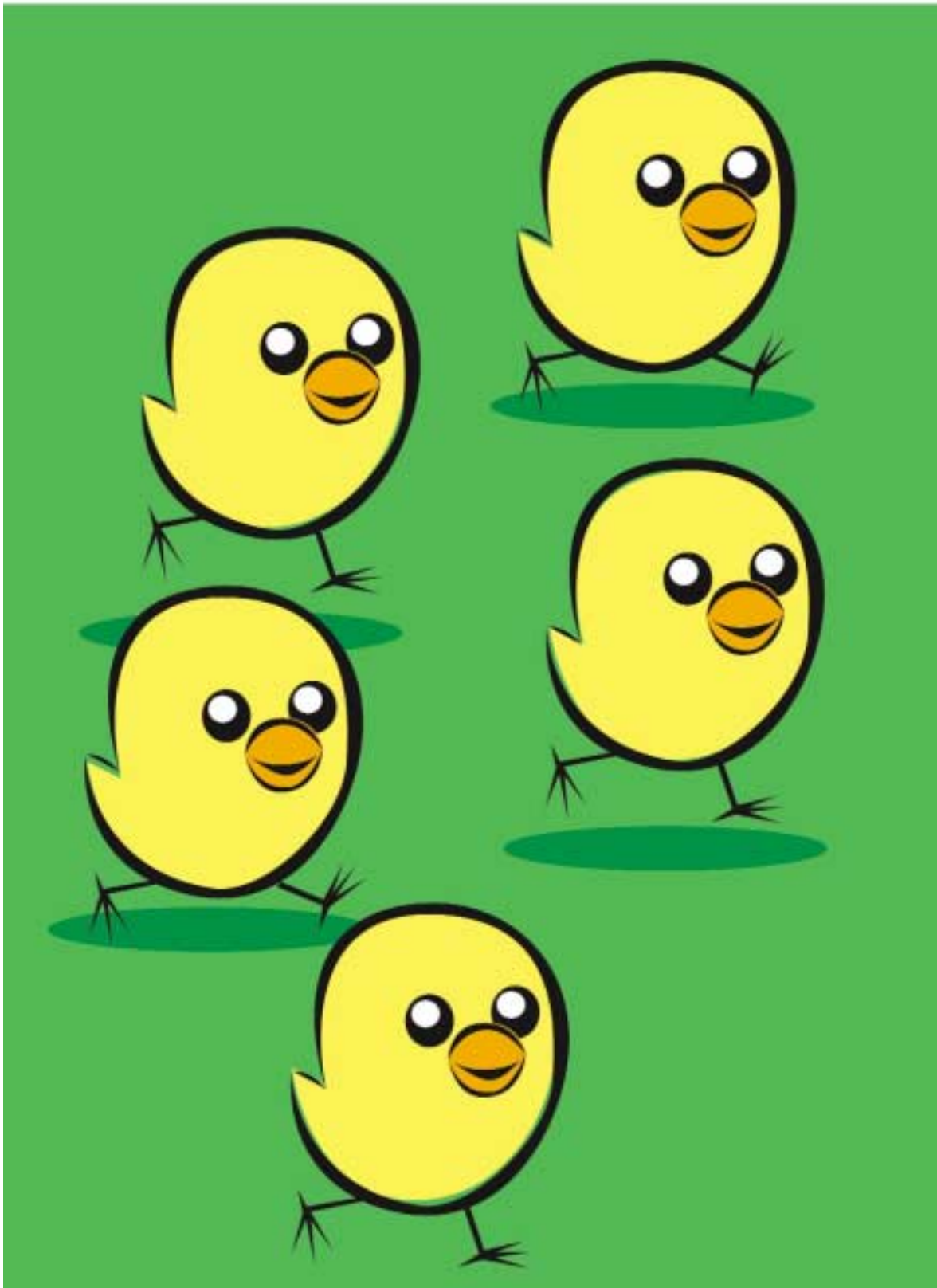

CHICKENS ARE AMAZING ANIMALS! DID YOU KNOW . . .

CHICKENS WERE DOMESTICATED ABOUT 8,000 YEARS AGO. THE CHICKEN WAS ONCE CONSIDERED A SACRED ANIMAL SYMBOLIZING THE SUN.



ALL DOMESTIC CHICKENS ARE RELATED TO *GALLUS GALLUS*, THE RED JUNGLE FOWL.

HENS AND CHICKS TALK WITH EACH OTHER . . . EVEN WHILE THE CHICK IS STILL INSIDE THE EGG!



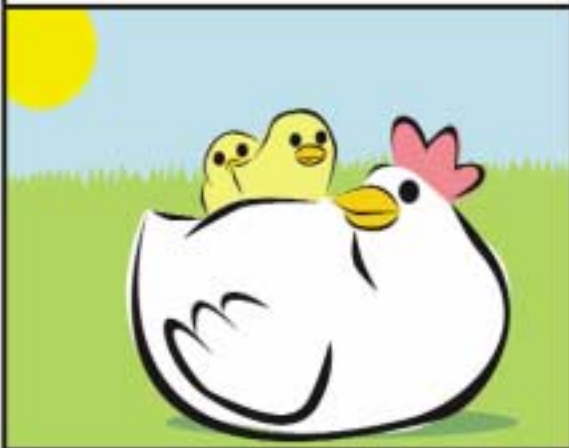
A MOTHER HEN WILL PROTECT HER BABIES FROM DANGER.



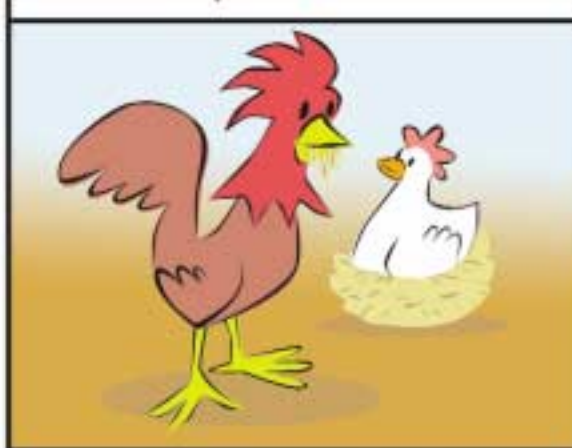
HENS WILL LET THEIR BABIES HIDE UNDER THEIR WINGS IN RAIN ...

ROOSTERS HELP HENS BUILD NESTS OUT OF TWIGS, HAY, FEATHERS, AND DIRT.



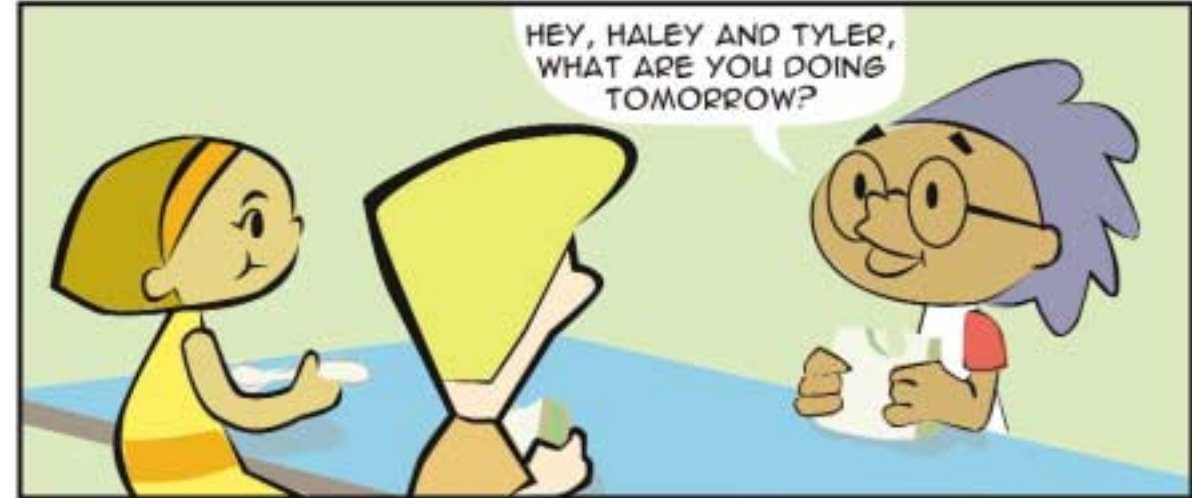

WHAT DO YOU MEAN SHE "TOLD" YOU?

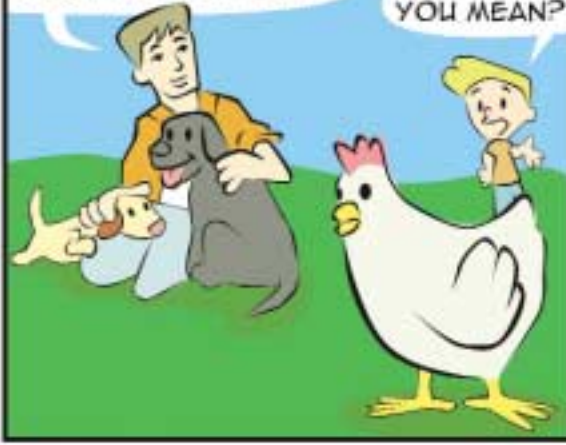

SHE WANTS TO TAKE DUST BATHS ...

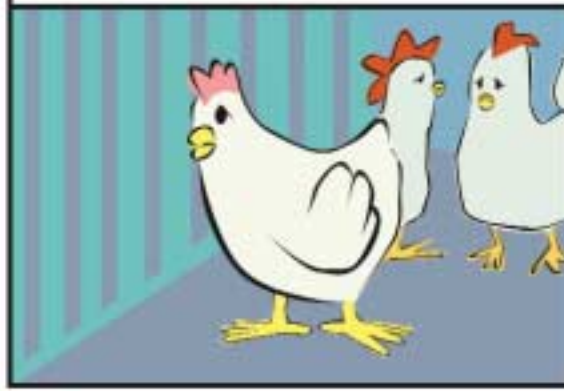


WHEN CHARLOTTE FIRST CAME HERE, WE WEREN'T SURE THAT SHE WOULD KNOW WHAT TO DO.

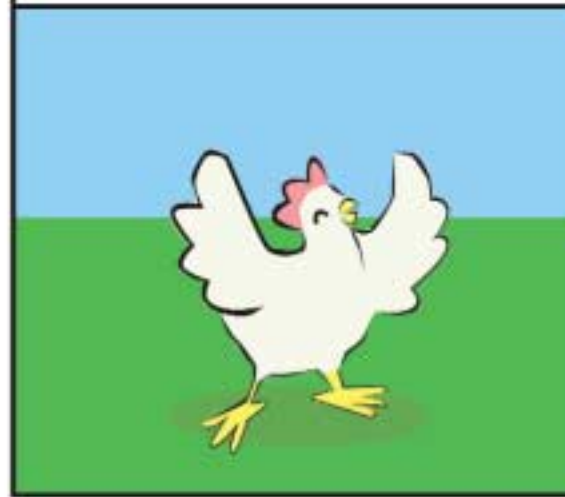


WHAT DO YOU MEAN?

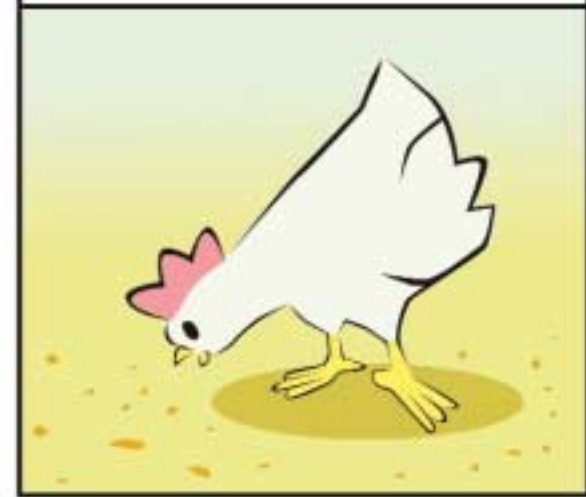

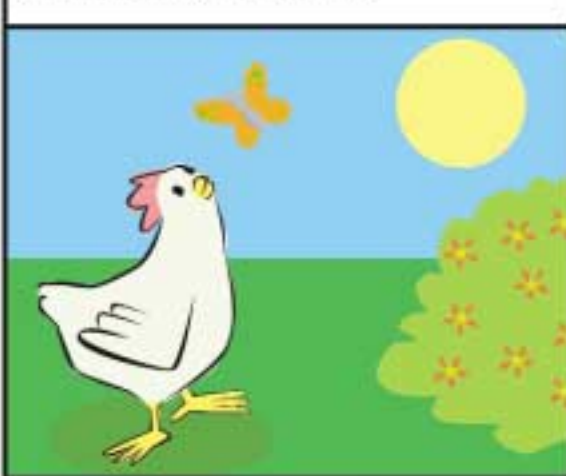
... STRETCH HER WINGS ...

BUT ON BIG FARMS, HENS RAISED TO LAY EGGS LIVE LESS THAN TWO YEARS . . .

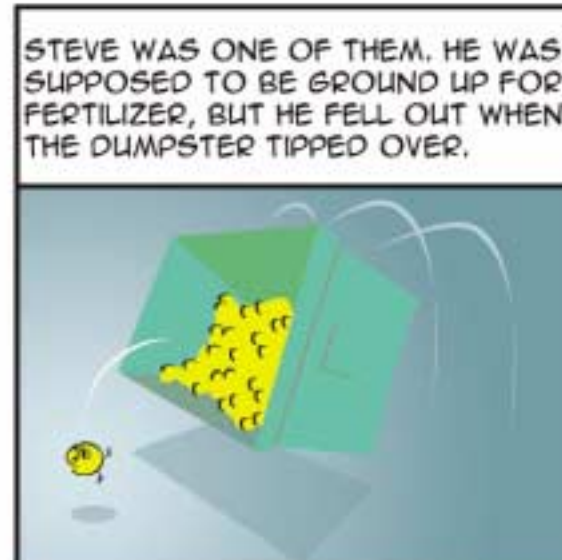


THAT'S HORRIBLE! WHAT'S STEVE'S STORY?

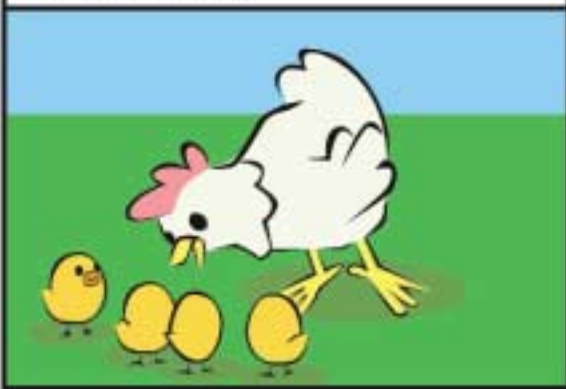

AND I'M GLAD THAT I CAN HELP CHICKENS, TOO.

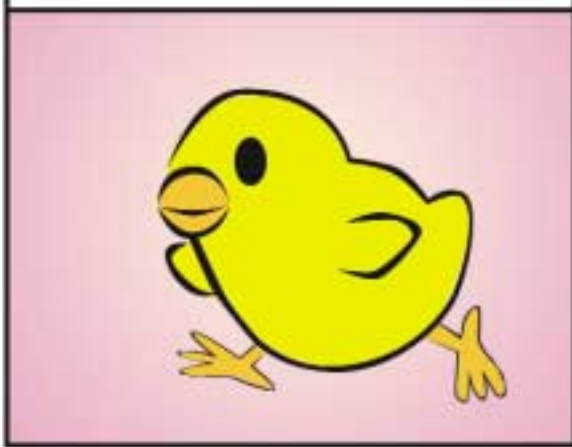
WHAT CHICKENS DO YOU HELP, ZACH?

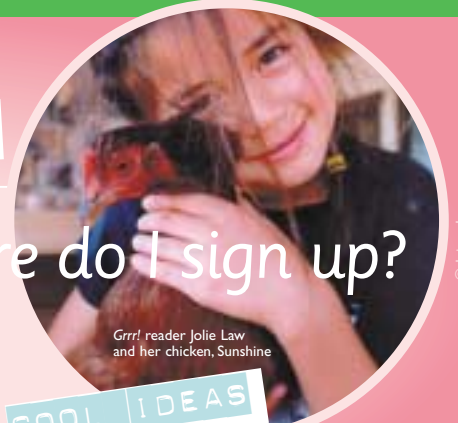
